



AOY Point Calculation

Points are determined by the number of participants per event. The maximum number of points at each event is the total number of teams entered in the tournament. The more participants the more points rewarded. In the event of a tie at any placement, the anglers will share the higher number of points that can be earned. If your team decides not weigh-in, you will be tied for last place and will automatically receive 1 point for that tournament.

The top three teams with the most points after the 4th event, will be awarded Douglas Rods Big Money Opens Trophies. First place will receive AOY Trophies and sponsorship contributions.

Substitutions are allowed, however all awarded team points are retained/carried by the boater of the team. Co-anglers cannot transfer the points (full or half) over to a new team/boater. Please make the tournament director aware of any substitutions prior to the event.
